Diploma of Equine Dentistry Training Information 2020-a

This is a brief overview of the Diploma of Equine Dentistry course provided by the Australian Equine Dental Practice (AEDP). Please refer to full course documentation for explanatory information.

Qualification	AEDP Diploma Equine Dentistry
Dates and Duration	Distance education part 1 from 23 Mar 2020 to 19 Jun 2020 Practical education part 1 from 22 Jun 2020 to 17 Jul 2020 Distance education part 2 from 20 Jul 2020 to 28 Aug 2020 Practical education part 2 from 31 Aug 2020 to 18 Sep 2020
Delivery	Via distance education with practicals based in Melbourne Australia
Course Objectives	To be able to attend to the routine and advanced care of equine dentition and the oral cavity. To provide assessment, treatment and post-treatment care with consideration to the overall health of the patient.
Course Model	Distance education is alternated with on site education to develop theoretical grounding and practical aptitude in a stimulating format. Regular testing aims to encourage the building of knowledge which is applied with practical proficiency.
Admission Prerequisites	Preferred are a combination of one or more of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Secondary education with post-secondary education and horse experience • Tertiary education and appropriate horse experience • Mature age applicants who may not meet the educational requirements but can demonstrate considerable horse experience and appropriate learning aptitude.
Fees	Training fees \$24,200. Application fee \$220. Half the training fee is payable upon acceptance and the other half prior to commencement of the practical training stage. Some finance options are available. Course fees also cover 12 months post-training support.
Applications	An application may be made on the forms supplied and must be accompanied by the non-refundable application fee.
Equipment Required	A complete set of equipment at a standard which meets or exceeds the specification of the standard AEDP instrument set. The AEDP instruments set can be ordered at a cost of \$7,800 including 10% GST.
Accommodation	Full board in Melbourne for the duration of the practice stages can be provided for additional cost.
